Hi

First of all I want to say that this email is not written to form a threat against you. I have discovered an article that can make the UcDi application fall. This is not good for you but also not good for us since it makes our recent patent applications much less worth. Maybe you would be able to handle this problem once you find out but I just wanted to give you a head start as it could be positive from an intellectual property standpoint.

The article was written 1980 by Vanderkoy and Lipshitz and was published in AES (<http://quad405.com/jaes.pdf>) . On page 6 you will find a block diagram and text about a main amplifier having an auxiliary amplifier comparing the input and output and acting on a summation point on the main amplifier. The only thing not mentioned is the clamp in the UcDi patent but I am worried that the inventiveness of that is too small.

Please have a look and consider possibilities.
